is under the supervision of the Va'ad HaRabanim of Greater Seattle and certified Kosher year-round, **excluding Passover:**

Consumer Orders:

- Ⓚ Customer must verify at time of cutting that the fish is of a kosher species by seeing fish raw with skin on. Pre-cut fillets with a skin tab and salmon may be purchased without further supervision. A Vaad mashgiach is available upon request for supervision of cutting.
- Ⓚ Customer should request that fish cut to order be processed with kosher knives on the kosher boards.
- Ⓚ Fish should be weighed on clean paper (not touching the scale).
- Ⓚ Fish cakes and pickled fish must have mashgiach present at time of preparation. The mashgiach must place appropriate Va'ad seals on product.

Commercial Orders:

- Ⓚ Commercial orders are available by prior arrangement with the Va'ad for supervision, and are certified when bearing two Va'ad kosher seals on the box or container. Fillets with skin tabs and salmon may be ordered even without a Vaad mashgiach present for the cutting.

Ground Fish:

- Ⓚ Ground fish is only available in Va'ad sealed packaging (each package must have two seals with the Va'ad symbol, or through special arrangement with the Va'ad.)

The Va'ad supervises *no other products* at this Vendor. The Fish and Chips is not certified by the Seattle Va'ad.

This Certificate is valid through December 31, 2011.
